Many landscaping companies that mostly use gas-powered leaf blowers do have battery operated leaf blowers. You can negotiate a *NO - Gas-Powered Leaf Blower* contract with your landscaping company to:

- (1) use battery operated leaf blowers on your property
- (2) limit such leaf blowers to the spring and fall cleanups
- (3) ask for rakes to be used in tandem with electric blowers to avoid moving large piles of leaves across a yard or if they are not strong enough for spring clean-up
- (4) use brooms/rakes on driveways to limit blowing dust/pollen onto neighbours yards
- (5) specify how many hours and how many battery blowers you want used
